

HRSA-Sponsored Primary Care Practice Transformation Grant



Are you ready to transform your practice to succeed in the new value-based primary care environment?

The Program:

- Training of primary care clinicians in practice transformation to prepare for value-based care such as Patient-centered Medical Home (PCMH) or Accountable Care Organizations (ACO).
- Eligibility: Primary Care Physician or PA, in practice for at least two years, who see medically underserved patients.
- Commitment: One half-day per week for one year. MOST OF THIS is working on your practice transformation project!
- Your practice **will be reimbursed** for your time commitment in this program.

Your Commitments:

- Assessment of your practice transformation readiness
- *Lean Six Sigma* quality improvement training: 6 month online curriculum mentored by Lean Six Sigma “black belt”
- Monthly webinar with faculty at MUSC – may be completed remotely
- Practice-based Quality Improvement project for your home practice – mentored by MUSC faculty with design, data and analytic support
- Required attendance at your state specialty meeting to present your QI work and attendance at the annual meeting of all HRSA-sponsored grantees (8-12-19 this year).
