**TO: Providers of Administrative Claiming and Special Needs
Transportation in State Agencies**

**SUBJECT: Continuation of Reimbursements under the Medicaid Program for
School-Based Administration and for some Special Needs
Transportation**

The United States Congress has passed legislation, which extends the moratorium on final rule (CMS-2287-F) regarding Medicaid reimbursement for school-based administration and special needs transportation. Based on the passage of this legislation, Federal Medicaid payments will continue to be available for administrative activities performed by school employees or contractors, or anyone under the control of a public or private educational institution, and transportation from home to school and back for school-aged children through June 30, 2009.

Therefore, the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services will continue reimbursement for administrative activities for continuation of this program and special needs transportation through June 30, 2009.
