# **MEDICAID BULLETIN**

**TO: Medicaid Hospice Providers**

**SUBJECT: Community Long Term Care Overlap Procedures and Medicaid Reimbursement Training**

The South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) is offering four training sessions to cover procedures related to services that overlap with recipients of Community Long Term Care (CLTC) and who have elected the hospice Medicaid benefit. Also covered in these training sessions will be an update on reimbursement procedures specifically related to the nursing facility room and board procedure code T2046.

The training sessions have been organized to include specific CLTC geographical regions so that hospice agencies that provide services in those regions will be able to meet CLTC staff and discuss procedural situations. Hospice providers are asked to register for the session where the majority of their clients reside. All training sessions will be held in Columbia, South Carolina at Blue Cross/Blue Shield – GBC, 17 Technology Circle, Farrow Road from 10:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Participants may begin arriving at 9:00 a.m. The workshop schedule allows for a lunch break; however, DHHS will not provide lunch. There is a cafeteria available on-site.

Session IV – Wednesday, March 5, 2008

CLTC AREA OFFICES – Anderson, Greenwood, Greenville, Spartanburg
