TO: Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) and Hospice Providers

SUBJECT: Updates to Interaction Between Medicaid HCBS Waiver Programs and the Hospice Benefit

Effective Jan. 1, 2025, the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) is updating its hospice and HCBS waiver policies to remove limitations on simultaneously receiving both HCBS and hospice services. This change only applies to HCBS waiver participants who are enrolled in the Community Choices, HIV/AIDS and Mechanical Ventilator Dependent waiver programs.

Training
