SUBJECT: Medicaid Insurance Verification Services (MIVS) – Third Party Liability (TPL) Support Services

Effective November 1, 2011, the Medicaid Insurance Verification Services (MIVS) contract will no longer be administered by Affiliated Computer Services, Inc. Blue Cross Blue Shield of South Carolina (BCBSSC) will be performing the following services on behalf of the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS):

- Verification and maintenance of Medicaid beneficiary primary health insurance in the Medicaid Information Management System (MMIS);
- Management of the Health Insurance Premium Payment (HIPP) program;
- Support services to the retro Medicare, retro health and pay and chase benefit recovery invoices;
- Cash receipts for provider, insurer, and beneficiary refunds to the Medicaid program, to include credit balance reviews and collections from inactive provider accounts;
- Support services for the Casualty and Estate Recovery departments of SCDHHS.
