Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

The funding will be used to connect families with fresh fruits and vegetables. We will educate and feed underserved communities where lack of access to fresh food and transportation is limited. We will grow, purchase and deliver food and water to alleviate hunger. Additionally, these funds will be used to support the routine provision of increased access to affordable fresh foods (fruits and vegetables) to target zip codes in the Midlands of SC, where residents do not usually have access to such due low socioeconomic status and marginalized geographic locations. The increased availability of affordable healthy foods is hypothesized, with evidence basis, to increase routine consumption of such, which will lead to increases in better health outcomes and lower health disparities among residents. This is also can potential help reduce healthcare costs for the targeted catchment area.
