SUBJECT: Dual eligibles (Medicare/Medicaid) placed into FFS for an undetermined period of time until the SCDuE Demonstration Project is implemented in July 2014.

OBJECTIVE: To revise the State Plan to reflect this decision (removal of a check mark)

BACKGROUND: This information is located in Attachment 3.1-F, Page 5, Section 2i.

1. Currently, the Duals have a choice of a PCCM model (MHN).
2. Upon approval the Duals will not have a choice until SCDuE Demonstration is implemented in July 2014. During this window of time SCDHHS is only acting as a secondary payer.
3. July 2014 choice will be reinstated to allow enrollment into the SCDuE Demonstration Project which will test fully integrated and coordinated delivery systems for primary care, behavioral health and long-term care for Medicare and Medicaid. BUDGETARY IMPACT:

EXPECTED OUTCOMES:

Transition approximately 15,000 members to FFS until July 2014.

This targeted population will qualify for the SCDuE demonstration project.

EXTERNAL GROUPS AFFECTED: Health Plans, and PCPs that have duals, who are contracted with MHNs

RECOMMENDATION: Approval
