  - About 400 opt-outs and 1,600 TPL
- Managed Care Selection
  - Over 8,000 have selected a plan

    - Claims, encounters
  - Planning next communications

  - Two part for FFS and Capitations
- Provider Actions
  - Self-Attestation starting January 18<sup>th</sup>

- Payments
  - FFS
    - As part of regular claims payment
    - First payment in March for YTD services
  - Capitated Payments
    - By June 2013 (CY Q2) for CY Q1 Services
