Cancer screening services: Identify needs assessment for each individual patient for United States Preventive Services Taskforce ("USPSTF") recommended cancer screening; counsel patients and arrange for cancer screening.	\$30,000.00	Costs would include HR costs for counsellors, weekly meetings, contacting patients, coordinate and facilitate collaboration with relevant support system including American Cancer Society ("ACS"), Best Chance network and mobile cancer screening agencies.
Access to cancer treatment: Identify needs assessment based on insurance, include uninsured, underinsured, financial resources, free drug programs, various foundations, and resources for insuring uninsured patient populations with cancer	\$60,000.00	Costs would include HR costs for counsellors, weekly meetings, collaboration with relevant support systems including funding for insurance premiums for uninsured and underinsured patients
Access to comprehensive genomic profiling	\$10,000.00	Costs would include research coordinator cost, clounseling and consenting patient, data entry, data analytics, preparing summary report and then write research paper for publication
Hereditary or germline cancer testing	\$50,000.00	Costs would include research coordinator cost, clounseling and consenting patient, data entry, data analytics, covering cost of testing for uninsured patients, and preparing summary report and then write research paper for publication
Social Determinants of Health (SDoH) and identify insurance status; (1) Mean family income; (2) Distance to travel to care and transportation options; (3) Food insecurity; (4) Language barriers; and (5) Literacy levels and cultural barriers in adoption of care.
