Purchase of a 26 passenger bus	\$25,000.00	This bus will be used to transport Pleasant Valley program participants to community events and outings. The program participants consists of senior adults, teens in our teen program and youth in our after-school and summer program.

Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

Pleasant Valley Connection has an aging fleet of buses that are currently used to transport program participants. Due to the condition of the buses we are limited on the distance that these buses will travel. Also due to the increase in the number of teens we are currently serving in our program we are unable to transport all of them on the 14 passenger bus. We currently have 20 students in our after school program and we anticipate the summer camp enrollment to be 25 students. The bus will also be used to transport students from school to our after-school program. The 26 passenger bus would allow us to transport all of the students on one vehicle when they are attending local cultural and enrichment events. With a newer vehicle students will be able to visit college campuses across the state and in neighboring states. This resource would also help transport Pleasant Valley residents to the polls to vote and to attend local cultural and community events.
