## MEDICAID ALERT

**TO: Behavioral Health Providers**

**SUBJECT: Outpatient and Rehabilitative Behavioral Health Services Managed Care Training**

In a further effort to provide Healthy Connections members with comprehensive and coordinated care, the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) is currently preparing to include all outpatient and Rehabilitative Behavioral Health Services (RBHS) in the Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) core benefit package. Providers wishing to continue to provide outpatient and RBHS must attend one of the trainings listed below. While all providers are welcome to attend, these trainings will focus on **private and public providers currently providing Community Support Services and other outpatient mental health services.** These trainings will inform providers on how to contract and provide these services within a Medicaid managed care program.
