

SC Nurse Aide Training Program Hour Requirements:

- 60 classroom hours (40 lecture and 20 skills training hours) + 40 clinical hours = 100 hours
All state-approved South Carolina Nurse Aide Training Programs must provide a minimum of 100 training hours. 60 classroom lecture hours that includes documentation of 20 hours dedicated towards skills training. The remaining 40 hours are required for clinical skills training in a hospital or an approved nursing facility.

Instructor requirements:

Primary Instructor (RN) experience- must possess a minimum of two (2) years RN nursing experience, to include at least one (1) year in the provision in long term care nursing services.

This is the only instructor that needs to submit the following information with the nursing aide training application:

- Current Sled report <5 years
- resume experience
- RN license #

Supplemental instructors working under the Primary Instructor (RN) must be a licensed RN or LPN and have at least one (1) year of experience in caring for the elderly or chronically ill of any age.
