MEDICAID BULLETIN

TO: Autism Spectrum Disorder Services Providers

SUBJECT: Addition of New Covered Autism Spectrum Disorder Services

Effective for dates of service on or after July 1, 2024, the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) will add coverage of additional autism spectrum disorder (ASD) services. This coverage expansion applies to full-benefit South Carolina Healthy Connections Medicaid members. The new covered services announced in this bulletin will be added to the ASD Services provider manual and ASD fee schedule available on SCDHHS' website by July 1, 2024. SCDHHS is making these changes to support greater access to ASD services, enhance the state's provider network and ensure services are delivered effectively. The addition of these services will complete the available service array for Healthy Connections Medicaid members for ASD services.

Reimbursement Rates for New ASD Services

Reimbursement rates for the additional ASD services described in this bulletin are included in the table below.
