Error Comments: Comments for all sections: South Carolina's Part C System encountered multiple challenges related to timely submission of the Child Count and Settings data. State staff were relocated to the S.C Department of Health and Human Services on 01mar17 in advance of a State Lead Agency change effective 01jul17. In attempting to submit the data on 05apr17, the EMAPS site was blocked by the agency's IT security. On that same data. the state experienced an outbreak of severe weather resulting in loss of power and internet access (https://www.weather.gov/cae/april_5_2017_event_review.html) . Following the resignation of the SC Part C Data Manager on 15apr17, the Part C Coordinator has assumed all data reporting activities until such time as new data manager is hired.
