Comment: Section E: As the state lead agency for IDEA/Part C, the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) has implemented processes to integrate the IDEA/Part C data system with the SCDHHS data systems for Medicaid eligibility and provider payment. In the process of data uploads from SCDHHS to IDEA/Part C, the SCDHHS data systems used the default CMS codes for race and ethnicity. This resulted in incorrect counts for the Part C Child Count reports. This re-submission reflects correction to the race and ethnicity for the cumulative child count for the same reporting period. 11 children were excluded from the cumulative child count, as updated ethnicity and race information was not received from service coordinators.
