
Plan/Accounting of how these funds will be spent:

Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

This initiative is vital for South Carolina as a state because many in-state students and certainly students that arrive at the doors of colleges from other states, portend a financial liability to institutions and the state when they arrive uninsured and/or underinsured. Many do not have a primary care provider and will continue for many reasons (e.g., lack of finances, lack of parental insurance coverage, etc.) to utilize local emergency rooms to manage their health care. Local South Carolina Departments of Health may or may not exist depending on where the school is located and thus may not be an option to access health care or treatment. Based on the HBCU healthcare assessment completed during FY 2020 (prior to COVID), we confirmed that many local doctors are overwhelmed and are NOT receptive to treating uninsured/underinsured students. This reality again impacts our state because students delay on-set into prevention and medical care and do not show up until they are severely ill.
