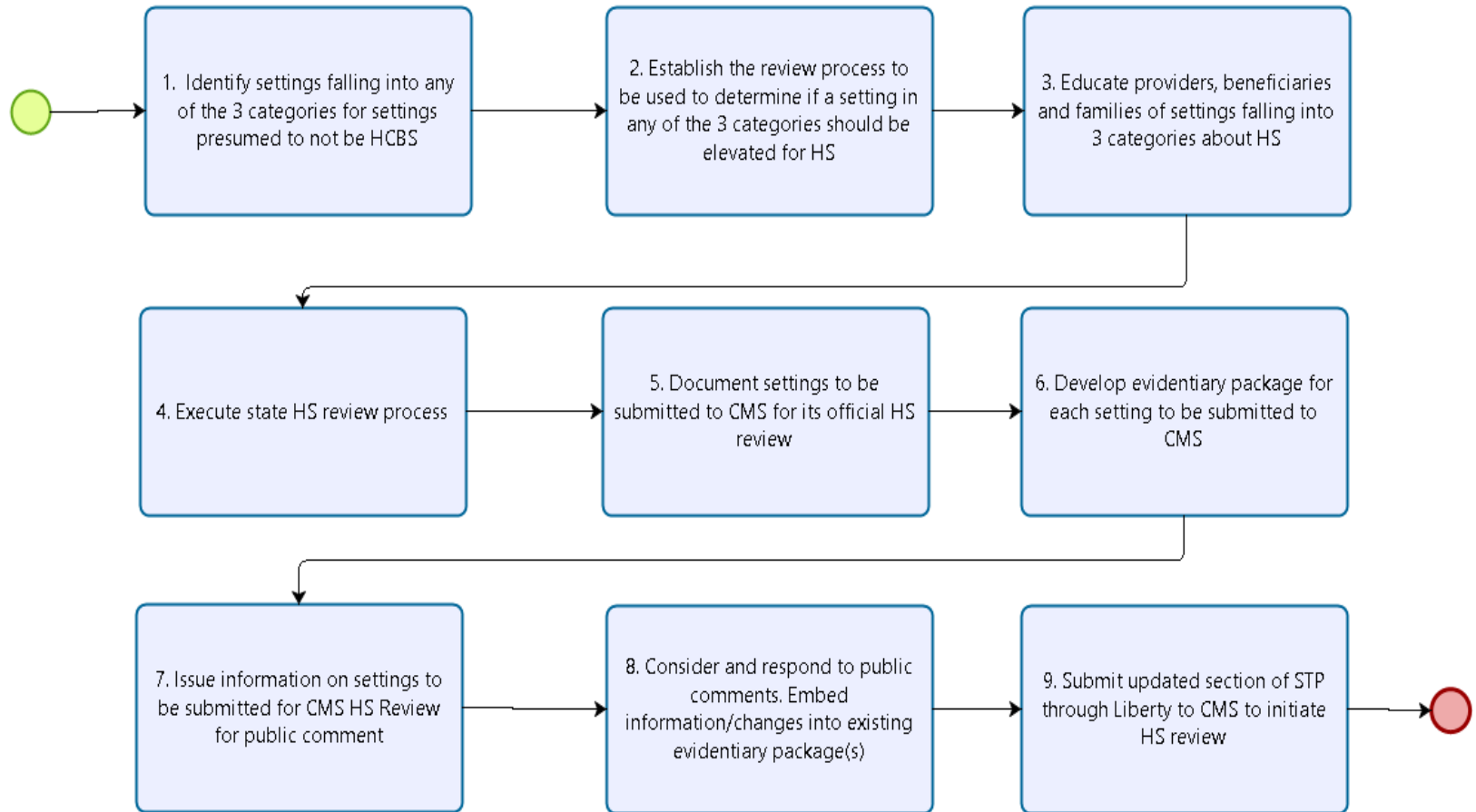

Statewide Transition Plan (STP)

- STP submitted to Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for final approval consideration
 - Submitted to CMS by Oct. 11, 2019

HCB Settings Quality Review Process: SCDDSN Settings (continued)

- Also called “state-level review”
- Information can be found at the SCDHHS HCBS website (2)
- State-level review process detailed in section 5 of STP
- Anticipate state-level review process to begin by the end of 2019

HCB Settings Quality Review Process: SCDDSN Settings (continued)

- Stakeholder Advisory Committee:
 - Membership from:
 - Advocacy community
 - Self-advocates
 - Provider community
- Trainings held in October
 - Non-residential (day) settings
 - Residential settings

HCBS Compliance – 2022 and Beyond

- As a reminder, CMS is clear:
 - ALL HCB settings must be in compliance by 2022
 - There is NO remediation for any non-compliant setting after that date
 - If a setting is non-compliant, the state cannot claim federal financial participation (FFP) for any services provided in that setting
