Statewide Transition Plan (STP)

- Currently under revision to include updates:
 - Systemic changes made
 - Settings assessment process and results
 - State-level heightened scrutiny processes
- Plan must include all elements defined by CMS (1)
- Prepping for CMS “Final Approval” consideration:
 - Goal is to post for public notice in April 2019
 - Goal is to submit to CMS by July 1, 2019

ADHC Home and Community-Based (HCB) Settings Quality Review Process

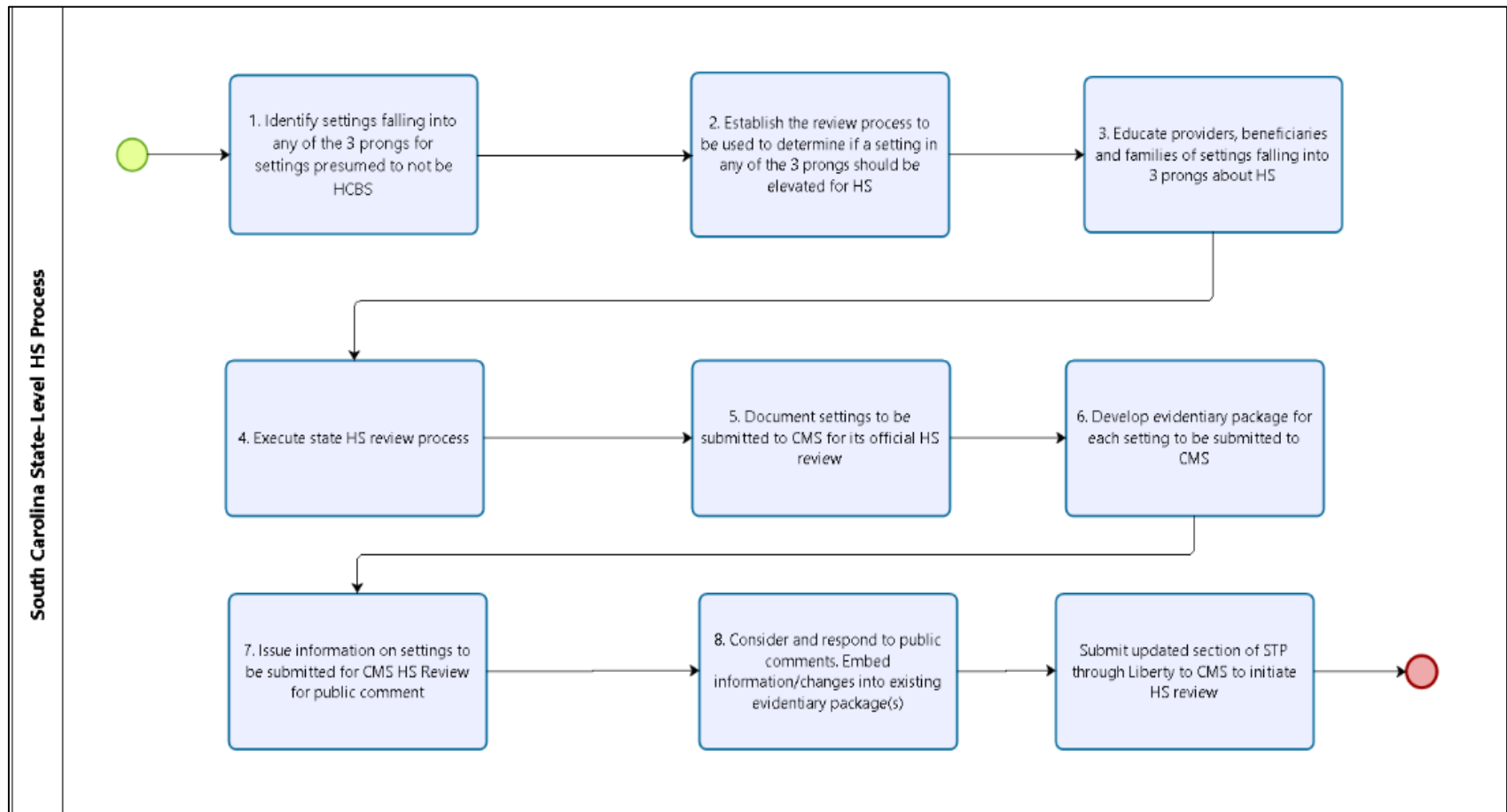
- External Review Committee:
 - Met Jan. 10 to make determination on setting
 - No other settings have been presented at this time for review
- Statewide Transition Plan (STP) will be updated to reflect process, outcome
- STP is scheduled to go out for public notice in spring
- Provider reminder:
 - Work on your approved correction action plan (CAP) action steps
 - Must be implemented and documented
 - Will be assessed at every Medicaid Compliance Review

HCBS Project Plan Update

- SCDHHS Community Options and SCDDSN Waivers:
 - Staff jointly working on a project plan for all required HCBS compliance tasks
 - Includes:
 - Tracking policy/directive/manual updates
 - Monitoring private homes for potential isolation qualities
 - Monitoring waiver participants in non-SCDDSN community residential care facilities (CRCFs)
 - Development of non-disability specific settings
 - HCB setting compliance actions
 - State-level heightened scrutiny

HCB Settings Quality Review Process: SCDDSN Settings (Cont'd)

- SCDHHS and SCDDSN staff continue to meet to work on process

- Drafting:
 - Site visit process for these settings
 - Review process for settings

HCBS Compliance – 2022 and Beyond

- As a reminder, CMS is clear:
 - ALL HCB settings must be in compliance by 2022
 - There is NO remediation for any non-compliant setting after that date
 - If a setting is non-compliant, the State cannot claim federal financial participation (FFP) for any services provided in that setting
- ***Do the work now!***

CMS HCB Settings Small Group Discussion Calls

- CMS created small group calls for HCB settings questions
 - Small groups organized by states
 - SC is in small group 2 (with AL, FL, GA, KY, MD, MS, NC, PA, VA, DC, WV)
 - Share ideas, strategies related to STP implementation
 - Raise issues for CMS attention
 - Have a CMS and an Administration on Community Living (ACL) representative on the call
- Next call: Feb. 11

Opioid Treatment Programs

- Reminder: SCDHHS will begin reimbursing for Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) in 2019
- Opioid treatment programs eligible to enroll on Jan. 1, 2019
 - Provide MAT to Medicaid beneficiaries diagnosed with opioid use disorder (OUD)
 - Benefit is fee-for-service (FFS) at this time
