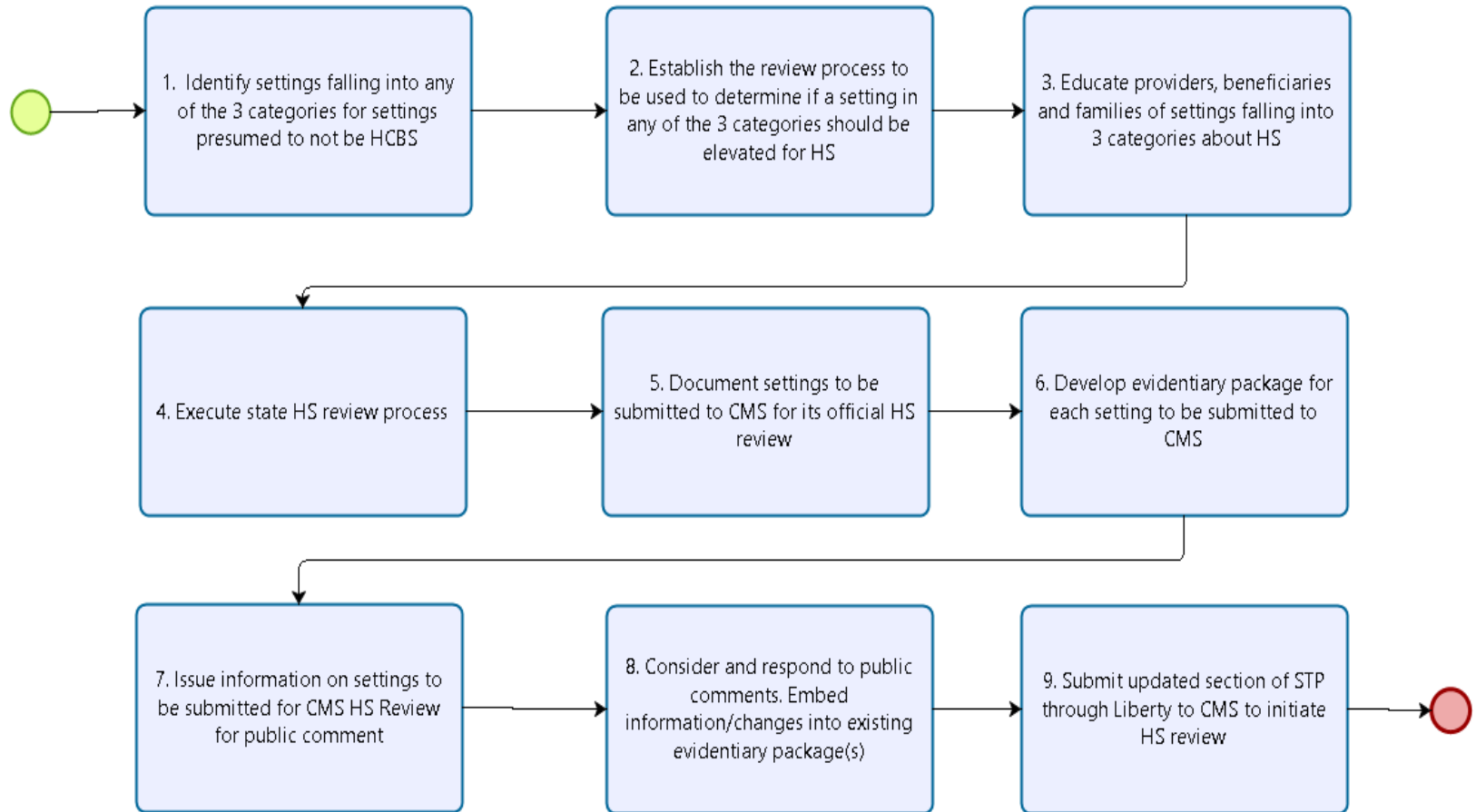

HCB Settings Quality Review Process: SCDDSN Settings (continued)

- Review team is currently reviewing submitted evidence packages
 - Information submitted by provider on the setting
 - Includes current residential observation
- Providers can continue to submit information on their settings in this process
 - Residential and day observations currently on hold
- SCDHHS and SCDDSN will communicate with providers once new timelines are established:
 - For submitting information to SCDDSN
 - For observations to resume
 - For public notice meetings
 - For heightened scrutiny decisions
