


# **HCBS updates: CMS implementation extension**

- CMS issued a state Medicaid director's letter on July 14, 2020 (2)
  - Deadline for full HCBS compliance extended to March 17, 2023
  - Included extended timelines for the heightened scrutiny process
  - Letter is posted on the SCDHHS HCBS website
    - > Under "Members & Families" (3)
    - > Under "Providers" (4)

### HCB Settings Quality Review Process: SCDDSN Settings (continued)

- CMS revised deadlines for the heightened scrutiny process:
  - Category 2 settings (next to or on the grounds of a public institution) submitted to CMS no later than March 31, 2021
  - Category 3 settings (has the effect of isolating individuals):
    - If the setting can be remediated by July 1, 2021, it's not submitted to CMS for heightened scrutiny review; must still be publicly listed
    - If the setting can be remediated, but can't be until after July 1, 2021, it must be submitted to CMS by Oct. 31, 2021



### HCB Settings Quality Review Process: SCDDSN Settings (continued)

- SCDHHS and SCDDSN will communicate with providers once new state timelines are established:
  - For submitting information to SCDDSN
  - For observations to resume
  - For heightened scrutiny decisions
  - For public notice meetings
- Providers can continue to submit information on their settings in this process
- Review team is currently reviewing submitted evidence packages
