Key takeaways (Kelly's notes): Vermont's population is slightly bigger than Greenville County – their state has a much more "community" feel to it. Their philosophy to serving individuals with intellectual and/or development disabilities is different from SC's. The Vermont system seems to only focus on serving what we here in SC would call the people on our "Critical list" There do not appear to be clearly defined successful outcome measures (of services provided) for the individuals they do serve; however, they do provide one-to-one staffing Residential settings are largely foster (similar to the CTH I model) There may be things that SC could do for HCBS compliance that Vermont does; there may also be things SC should not do for HCBS compliance that Vermont does.
