1.	Workgroup Updates	<ul> <li>ID/RD Waiver Renewal: CMS sent an Informal Request for Additional Information (IRAI). SCDHHS has until 2/12/16 to respond; we have already requested an extension. Many of the questions require other agencies/organizations to provide us with information to answer the questions.</li> <li>PRIME/CLTC waiver updates: CLTC has an IRAI from CMS on the PRIME amendments; they are working on those now. Also working on the renewals for two waivers: Community Choices (CC) and HIV/AIDs. The PRIME amendments must go through and be approved by CMS first before CLTC can submit the CC and HIV/AIDS renewals</li> <li>1915(i) – the 1915(i) state plan amendment is currently on hold; SCDHHS is proceeding with a new 1915(c) waiver – the Palmetto Coordinated System of Care (PCSC)</li> <li>Person-centered planning: Group met on Wednesday 2/3/16; still working on a webpage for person-centered resources for the state; also looking at outreach/education for various stakeholders on person-centered thinking/planning. Next meeting scheduled for 3/2/2016</li> </ul>		
2.	Statewide Transition Plan (STP) updates	<ul> <li>As a recap: first STP submitted to CMS on 2/26/15. CMS sent feedback in August 2015 to make revisions. Revised STP submitted to CMS on 9/25/15. CMS sent additional feedback in November 2015. Second revision sent to CMS on 2-4-2016. This will be reviewed as a draft prior to the public notice on Feb. 24</li> </ul>		

		<ul> <li>STP draft current as of 2/4/2016 posted here. Can also go to SCDHHS HCBS STP Website: https://msp.scdhhs.gov/hcbs/site-page/statewide-transition-plan</li> <li>STP will go through another public notice and comment period Feb. 24 – March 25. That version will then be revised and submitted to CMS on March 31</li> <li>Revisions primarily include providing more details and dates of processes, how the state will make changes, how the state will monitor for ongoing compliance.         <ul> <li>Added many appendices for detailed information (so would not be in the narrative portion)</li> <li>Enhanced and explained the state's heightened scrutiny process (HCB Settings Quality Review)</li> <li>Included a relocation of waiver participants section</li> <li>Added a review of a Pediatric Medical Day Care (one setting in the Medically Complex Children's waiver)</li> <li>Moved the C4 Residential self- assessment into the Assessment of the System section (since providers were told to really assess their residential settings by program type – which is really more of a policy review)</li> </ul> </li> <li>The revisions and addition of information is all information that has been shared in the workgroup and on the HCBS website</li> <li>There will be a webinar on the STP revisions at the start of the public comment period</li> <li>Family Connections is hosting it on Wed. Feb. 24 at 11 a.m. (Kelly will forward email to group after minutes sent)</li> </ul>
3.	General Updates	<ul> <li>Heightened scrutiny site visits</li> <li>Kelly and Cassidy will start with ADHC's first, then do the DDSN Day programs next</li> <li>Will be revising the C4 day (non-residential) assessment to split into two: one for ADHC's and one for DDSN Day programs. Their missions are different enough that splitting it into two should provide us with a more accurate assessment of each program type.</li> <li>Question was asked if waiver participants who utilize these settings would be interviewed; Kelly said yes, but no set protocol has been determined yet.</li> </ul>

### **Meeting Minutes**

#### **Healthy Connections Communities: HCBS Rule Workgroup**

- Cassidy shared that she developed an Olmstead Rubric to assist in site visits of Day programs (attached in email with minutes). The rubric was based on the findings DOJ had in the Rhode Island case in2014. It is still in draft form, so if you have suggestions, please let Cassidy know. It will be used to see how we compare to the indicators DOJ used and determine how we can improve our system and services. It will be used for the site visits in addition to the revised C4 assessment.
- The question was brought up about the development of model leases (42 CFR 441.301(c)(4)(vi)(A) requirement).
   DDSN shared that some of their group had been discussing it (and working on one?). Judy Johnson shared that Babcock developed one and was happy to share with DDSN.
- Employment efforts for waiver participants was discussed.
   Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) Dept. working with DDSN on
   referrals and improved communication; DDSN committed
   to providing funding for long-term follow along supports.
   VR and DDSN also did a pilot project with 3 sites on
   employment opportunities for individuals with intellectual
   disabilities. Sites were Columbia, Greenwood, and
   Conway. A dedicated VR counselor was at each site to
   work specifically with people served by DDSN; Babcock is
   providing the follow-along support in Columbia. The other
   sites did not have as much utilization.
- DD Council had an Employment RFP funding opportunity and received several grant applications for the RFP. To whomever the grant is awarded will begin their project in July 2016. Also mentioned success of Project SEARCH working with young adults/students transitioning
- Kelly asked the group what would make these meetings more meaningful and useful to them beyond just sharing information. She wants to be mindful of people's time, while still utilizing the diversity of this group to have good discussion about the implementation of HCBS.
  - $\circ\quad$  Suggested to have a "Call for Agenda Items"
    - Kelly will do that for next meeting
  - Suggested to not have the March meeting (since will be in the middle of the public comment period for the STP); meet again in April

#### **Healthy Connections Communities: HCBS Rule Workgroup**

- Kelly will just send out a monthly update via email
- Cassidy suggested that the group could also use this time to tell us (Kelly and Cassidy) what we can do better, what we need to know as we move forward in the Transition period
  - Discussion revolved around communication with waiver participants (as it relates to our site visits).
     How it is done is important so that we get meaningful and accurate input
  - Suggested we could utilize IMPACT as a starting point to network with those self-advocates who could then connect us to self-advocates at the local level (local DSN board groups)
    - Babcock their group is BETA, meet monthly;
       Judy could help us get on their agenda for a meeting
    - Aiken also has a group
    - York has a group
    - Conversations with the advocate group members could be very informative and could share information
  - Suggested we could also look at the NCI data to assist in getting waiver participant feedback; they have a validated protocol and compare state date to nationwide data
- Discussion also around the topic of general public perception of people with disabilities
  - Are still issues with the school system segregating students with disabilities from their peers – even their local peers – so that they are unable to get to know other students in their local neighborhoods and communities (cannot build social capital)
  - There is a movement to push for self-directed IEP's (individualized education programs); Supported Decision Making models (in place of guardianship)
  - Family Connections recently awarded the PTI grant for education and training for parents (<a href="http://www.familyconnectionsc.org/press-releases.html">http://www.familyconnectionsc.org/press-releases.html</a>)
