To help coordinate care, she reached out to a fellow self-advocate (Saquan Brown) who offered to talk to his agency, and actually gave her another agency to contact as his could not accommodate her request. Emphasized that the professionalism, courtesy, and general willingness to help someone who has specific needs for travel makes the overall experience much more positive.
