Settings site visits	 PCG has been doing pilot site visits during February No written feedback has been given to SCDHHS on any of the sites, but Kelly is happy to share them with the providers directly once she receives them. Kelly shared the webpage with the PCG information on it: https://msp.scdhhs.gov/hcbs/site-page/pcg-hcbs-site-visits Encouraged providers to share information with their staff The findings/reviews of the individual sites will not be published. The findings will be published in aggregate in the Statewide Transition Plan which will go through a public comment period. That is likely to be early 2018. Full implementation of the site visits statewide should begin this month; we will get an update on 3/3/2017 Question was asked on how compliance was determined.
