Home and Community Based (HCB) Settings Quality Review Process: South Carolina Department of Disabilities and Special Needs (SCDDSN) Settings	 South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) participated in the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Small Group monthly call on new CMS heightened scrutiny guidance. One takeaway from the call: States must put together an evidentiary package for settings submitted to CMS for heightened scrutiny (not new). CMS and Administration on Community Living (ACL) will look at the state's template for that package and offer feedback before official submission (if state requests). SCDHHS and SCDDSN had a call with CMS on new heightened scrutiny guidance Clarified public notice requirements for all steps in this part of the process Will need to update some of the Milestones submitted to CMS (and in the STP) as a result of new guidance ACL shared that at least one other state (Idaho) is doing training for families on HCBS, what that looks like for them as a family with their person living at home with them. Will be presenting with ACL soon – could be a good resource to help our families understand the goal of HCBS. Finalizing draft HCB Settings Quality Review process (revised due to new guidance) Will share with stakeholders in June for feedback Process will be revised based on feedback Will be included in STP for public notice
