HCBS Compliance – 2022 and beyond	<ul> <li>As a reminder, CMS is clear:         <ul> <li>ALL HCB settings <u>must</u> be in compliance by 2022</li> <li>There is <u>no remediation</u> for any non-compliant setting after that date</li> <li>If a setting is non-compliant, the state <u>cannot claim</u> federal financial participation (FFP) for any HCB services provided in that setting</li> </ul> </li> <li>Do the work now.</li> </ul>
