Funding will be designated for Prisma Health Midlands Foundation's CAMP KEMO Programs Fund. Funding is dedicated exclusively for CAMP KEMO Programs, an umbrella of year-round programs for children and teenagers served at the Children's Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders at Prisma Health Children's Hospital in Columbia, SC. Our programs are offered at no cost to families and are designed to alleviate some of the stress associated with a life-threatening illness and provide year-round fun, educational and therapeutic opportunities throughout the spectrum of care. The children served by our programs have been treated for childhood cancer and/or blood disorders such as Sickle Cell Disease. We provide services year round to our patients and families, at no cost to families. These services can change year to year based on need; however, at this time we are offering the following services throughout the year: Summer camp (one week for oncology and one week for blood disorders), teen retreats (for both populations), mothers support group, bereaved mothers support group, bereavement camp, family camp, granting of last wishes, family meals (both inpatient and outpatient), neuropsych testing and school support, financial assistance (including funeral assistance), comprehensive psychological evaluation and surveillance, mental health consultation, as well as playground and patient rewards programs to encourage children and teens during their cancer treatments. Prisma Health is a non-profit hospital system.
