
Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

Funding will be utilized for the full provision of counseling and treatment services to the adolescent population ranging in ages from 5 to 21. Costs covered will include operational costs, staffing costs, supplies, additional training, and more. Some children who enter into services have no pay source and would otherwise be considered indigent. A small Scholarship Fund would allow Sumter BHS to provide services to multiple children who otherwise would not afford that programming. The referrals coming into Sumter BHS for the previous year increased from local pediatricians who are experiencing more behavioral and emotional issues amongst their own patients; therefore seeking counseling. Funding will assist the agency in covering infrastructure costs associated with a physician partnership that would assist in more children reaching counseling services, and additional medical and/or testing services. Funding would aid Sumter BHS in operational costs including staffing or contractual fees, training, and other costs.


