


HEDIS-like Administrative Claims Data 2022 (reporting year 2023) First 30 Months of Life



WCC - First 30 Months of Life Comparison less than 15 months




WCC - First 30 Months of Life Comparison 15-30 months










Children's Core Measure Administrative Claims Data 2022 (reporting year 2023)

Fluoride Varnish (FV) in a Non-Dental Setting*




At-a-glance

- 1,488% increase in the number of Medicaid children receiving FV in a non-dental setting since 2011
- CY 2022 data
 - > About 76% of the children were 0-4-year-olds
 - ➤ About 21% were 5-12-year-olds










- Chlamydia screening for 16-20-year-olds
 - > QTIP practices remain above national 50% benchmark
- Appropriate testing for Pharyngitis
 - > QTIP practices are above the national 90% benchmark while non-QTIP practices are at the national 50% benchmark
- ADHD initiation AND continuation
 - > QTIP practices are above the national 90% benchmark



School-based MH Services

As of January 2023, MH counselorto-student ratio has improved from 1:1,300 in 2022 to 1:829.

of school-based MH counselors increased by 65.8%, rising from appx. 600 in 2022 to 995 in 2023.

118 schools gained access to MH counselors from 2022 to 2023.

of districts where each school had access to MH counseling rose from 35 in 2022 to 42 in 2023.

In 2023, nine additional districts have access to mental health counseling compared to 2022

Crisis Stabilization Services

\$45.5 Million in one-time infrastructure funds to build specialized ED units dedicated to treat psychiatric patients

Intent is to provide calm, safe, healing environment and provide immediate care using a multi-disciplinary team

Statewide in 13 locations; providing 37 child/youth specific spaces

Behavioral Health Hub – Pee Dee Region

Collaboration of SCDHHS, SCDMH, McLeod Health, MUSC, Francis Marion University and Hope Health

Services will include a combination of triage, crisis stabilization, telehealth, outpatient and inpatient services






