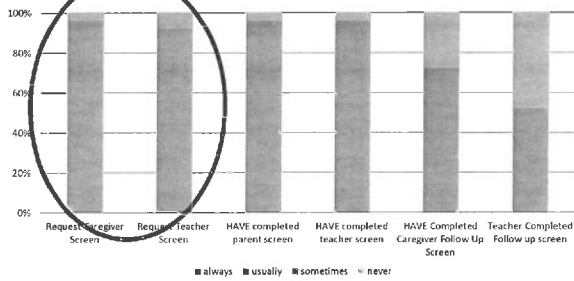

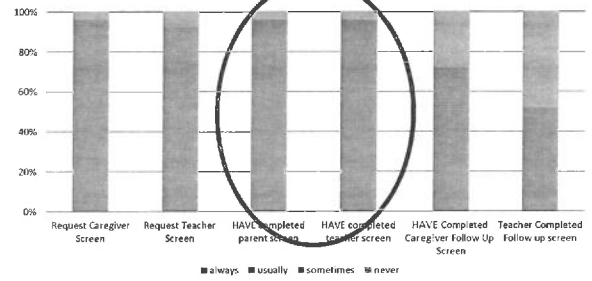

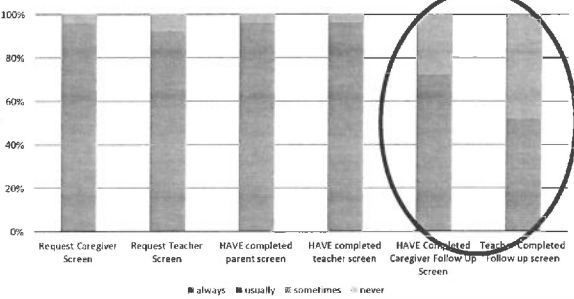
ADHD 2018 Data

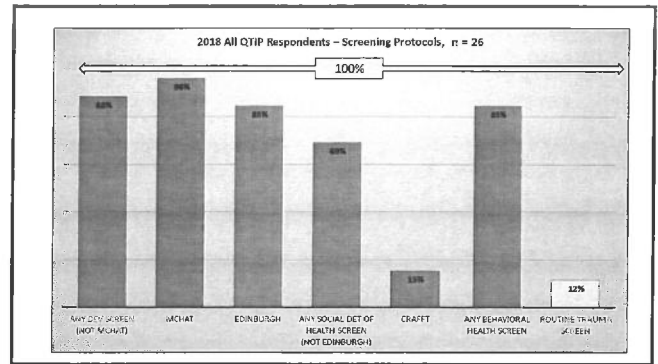

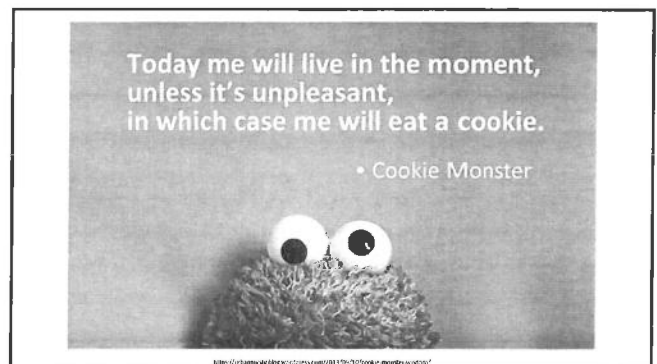
