Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)





WHY ADDRESS TOXIC STRESS?

Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE) study

- Attention problems, oppositional behavior, emotional dysregulation, sleep problems, toileting problems, anger, anxiety and depression.
- High risk for adverse health outcomes as an adult- cardiovascular, cancers, asthma, depression and autoimmune diseases.
- High risk behaviors like alcohol and drug addiction.
- o Enormous financial and personal cost.




