BREASTFEEDING RATES


- Initiation, 1mo,4mo,6mo rates

- Identifying and addressing co-morbidities




There's more than one way to do something.

- LACTATION CENTERS- Referral and feedback loop established
- Using dedicated Lactation counsellors
- Using the Hospital's Lactation consultant
- Using Lactation trained staff
- Breastfeeding plan
- Promoting Breastfeeding friendly Practice
- Coordinate with local WIC Lactation people




Breast Feeding Plan in Chart






Social Determinants Screen










Postpartum Depression Screen










Improving ADHD Care

How did they do it ?

- Making new patients appointment only after the Standardised screens are in
- Making the initial follow up appointment at the same time
- Giving 3 weeks worth Medication instead of 30 day supply
- Identifying and documenting co-morbidities a priority
- Creating ADHD folders




What Did the QIDA show?

• Fluoride Varnish






HOW DID QTIP DO?

- Dental home


