This project makes sustaining renovations to 5 campuses belonging to Project Hope Foundation, a local nonprofit with a 26-year history of providing autism services to individuals from 12 counties: Abbeville, Anderson, Cherokee, Greenville, Greenwood, Laurens, McCormick, Newberry, Oconee, Pickens, Saluda, Spartanburg. This project will benefit the citizens in the surrounding areas of each of the 5 renovated campuses, tocated in Central, Greenwood, Landrum, Spartanburg, and Woodruff. Each campus promotes public health by providing medically necessary services to autistic individuals and their families. These services impact the civic and economic health of the communities in which these families live. Project Hope, SC's largest autism service provider with 300 employees, currently serves 230+ autistic children and their families through skill-building therapy, 170+ autistic students through its own accredited school and collaboration with 30 other schools, and 30+ autistic adults through day programs and employment. Its reach is over 1,000 annually, with plans to double services over 3 years to address the hundreds of individuals waiting for services. These funds will address needs on 5 campuses, equipping this organization to focus on the autism services needed for the 1 in 36 children who are now being diagnosed.
