Plan/Accounting of how these funds will be spent:

The Cancer Association's mission "to lessen the burden on Anderson County residents who are battling cancer" includes A) financial and emotional support for patients and their families (see rack card) and B) helping survivors regain their quality of life. Since 2003, CAA has financially supported more than 10,000 individual cancer patients from across Anderson County, spending in excess of \$3.1 million in direct financial assistance. Limited space has been a constant issue for CAA in providing financial and emotional services to both patients and survivors. The new campus will help us expand services to both groups through the following therapies: 1). Learning to eat healthy for cancer & chronic disease prevention in our teaching kitchen, 2). Regaining mobility and function through our neuromuscular massage in designated spaces, 3). Dealing with pain and nausea through acupuncture, an evidence-based therapy to relieve these and other cancer and treatment-related symptoms, especially patients facing opioid addictions, 4). Connecting and garnering emotional support, utilizing our new multipurpose and community rooms that allow patients adequate space for community education classes and resources such as veterans-battling-cancer groups, support groups for specific types of cancer, wellness groups, exercise groups, etc., 5). Finding physical needs such as wigs, hats, mastectomy bras, and camisoles, specialty cancer treatment-related clothing, and home-health medical equipment FREE-OF-CHARGE in our enhanced boutique, 6). Meditating and reflecting in our courtyard, outdoor green spaces, and areas for honoring survivors and memorializing those who have died. Once completed, the Center for Hope & Healing Campus will provide space and resources to assist Anderson County residents with vital needs throughout their cancer journey and beyond as well as support their caregivers and families, while helping Survivors regain and maintain their quality of life.
