Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

In January of 2020, Worldview Ministry International, Inc. (WMI) completed acquisition of 12.37 acres close to the shelter (dba: North Strand Housing Shelter), with the vision of expanding transitional housing capacity. Development and operation of these acres has now been named "the Compass Neighborhood". The vision is that the neighborhood will include: transitional housing, a community center (gymnasium, classrooms, youth center), classes/ skills training, healthcare services, childcare services, vehicle repair, food services and recovery center. The neighborhood will be developed in phases, with Phase 01 focused on women and women with children. The mission of the overall project is to develop a neighborhood that empowers our vulnerable neighbors by providing access to affordable transitional housing, educational resources and life skills through a supportive community. We house families with children, Veterans and individual men and women.
