State funds, coupled with community donations as well as funding from Prisma Health will renovate and expand our Cancer Institute on the Oconee Medical Campus, allowing us to serve more cancer patients in a more comfortable, healing environment. Serving patients from Oconee, Pickens, Anderson Counties and nearby parts of Georgia, this larger space will enhance the patient's journey and experience as they receive high-quality, state-of-the-art cancer treatment in Seneca, South Carolina. This expansion will provide more comfort for patients, more providers, better cancer care right here so that patients do not have to travel outside their local community for quality healthcare. Total project cost is estimated at \$12 million. OMH Foundation is partnering with the community to provide 1/3 of the costs at \$4.25 million. This project is a beautiful partnership between our community, our state and the healthcare organization as we work together to enhance local quality care.
