Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

Funds will be used to provide Pace Center for Girls Reach Counseling Services in three (3) counties in South Carolina, Marion, Darlington and Florence. Specifically, Pace Reach provides social-emotional, behavioral, and mental health counseling, therapeutic services, and case management to at-risk adolescent girls ages 11-17, and their families. Services are free to the girls and families and are provided in school settings in partnership with public schools. Funds will also support coalition building efforts through the Girls Coordinating Council within the Pee Dee region, focused on holistically serving the community's most vulnerable girls by reforming systems to change outcomes. Pace is a nationally recognized prevention model that breaks generational cycles of poverty, abuse, and neglect so that girls realize a brighter future for themselves, their families and their communities. Girls come to Pace with histories of trauma, abuse, risky-behaviors, school failure, and family instability. Pace's integrated approach is gender specific, trauma-informed, and strength-based and combines life skills, counseling, and empowerment.
