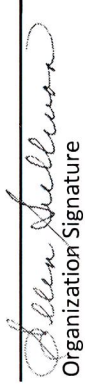

Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

The Pregnancy Center and Clinic of the Low Country provides free early prenatal medical care to uninsured and underserved women in Beaufort and Jasper Counties. The need for early prenatal medical care continues to increase in our community but a growing number of these women do not have the financial resources to pay for the care they receive. This care is critical to the health and welfare of both the mother and her baby. The services we offer are provided at no cost to our clients, address this essential need in our community, and contribute to the overall health quality in the regions. It is well documented that a healthy pregnancy is one of the best ways to promote a healthy birth. Getting early and regular prenatal care improves the chances of a healthy pregnancy and can prevent complications. Prenatal care provides women with important information on nurturing and protecting their infants, monitors existing health conditions, and identifies health problems that may arise during the pregnancy with a goal toward healthy moms and healthy babies. Pregnant women, their babies, families and the community benefit when moms and babies are given the opportunity to be healthy and well.

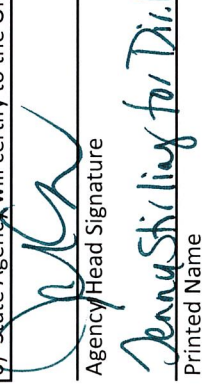
