Rural Health Services is a federally qualified health center operating four fixed sites and two mobile units in Aiken, SC. In 2023 Rural Health Services served over 15,000 and generated over 52,000 patient visits. Over 90% of patients served were less than 200% of poverty, over 27% were uninsured, 23% Medicaid, and 16% Medicare. All RHS facilities are located in medically underserved areas and serve all populations. No One will be denied access to health care or be discriminated against due to their inability to pay, nor on the basis of age, race, color, national origin, disability, religion, or sex (including pregnancy, sexual orientation, and gender identity). In programs, services, and/or activities sponsored by Rural Health Services. A discounted/sling fee schedule is available based on family size and income.
