| <p>Safe Harbor will use the funds to improve services and facilities for domestic violence victims. Funds will support the construction of a new domestic violence center; this facility replaces Safe Harbor's current shelter (100-year-old house) and will serve all Greenville County (location: 100 Gordon Street, Greenville). The Center includes:</p> <p><b>24-HOUR SHELTER</b> with 21 private family units, including bedroom, bathroom, and kitchenette. In addition to family units are thoughtful community spaces (kitchen/dining, teen/child spaces, multipurpose/wellness rooms). Shelter capacity will triple; this is critical, as almost 400 approved families were turned away in 2023 due to lack of space.</p> <p><b>SUPPORTIVE SERVICES CENTER</b>, including on-site mental health counseling, advocacy, legal assistance, support/education groups, and wellness activities. The campus plan co-locates all services &amp; staff (currently in 3 locations) and improves client access to services. Our current shelter is crowded and offers little privacy. The new Center significantly improves service quality/capacity.</p> |  |
