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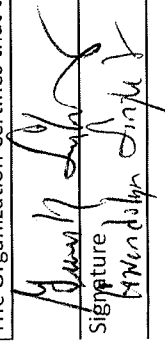
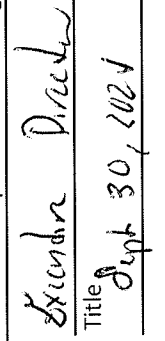

Situational Awareness to Identify & Understand the ill-effects of Diabetes Framework Approach for Zip Code 29203 Residents

To address the diabetes-related health challenges in the 29203 zip code, as well as the broader contexts of the United States and South Carolina, a situational awareness framework was developed. Its strategic value is essential to better understand as well as to develop effective solutions to the diabetes conditions.

This situational awareness framework will guide the project team to build a comprehensive understanding of diabetes-related problems, its impacts, and its contributing behavioral factors while also to provide a clear structure to action.

From there, the constructs of the pilot project could be build and its strategies could be executed, and its programs could be developed into a structured approach to building situational awareness about the current effects of diabetes on Zip Code 29203 Community. The objectives are to gain insight into the quantitative and qualitative aspects of diabetes, to identify the barriers and risk factors, and ultimately to create targeted solutions that address the unique needs of the community.

This framework approach will ensure that the Community Health Diabetes Management program is both effective and sustainable, in reducing the risk of diabetes and improve the overall health outcomes of the community (e.g., HbA1c control rates, complication rates).

**Situational Assessment of the Societal & Cultural Awareness
Structural Approach for Zip Code 29203 Residents**

To address the diabetes-related health challenges in the 29203 zip code, as well as the broader contexts of the United States and South Carolina, a situational awareness framework is performed in Q1FY24 in partnership with Dr. Pierre Barakat. This framework will guide the project team efforts in identifying and understanding the diabetes problem, its impacts, and its contributing factors. The situational awareness framework for assessing and addressing diabetes-related challenges will involve: 1) gathering information; 2) analyzing the present conditions; and 3) taking actionable steps.

Here, the situational awareness framework will allow us to build a comprehensive understanding of the diabetes-related problems in the 29203 zip code and surrounding areas. Along the quantitative elements of the situational awareness of the diabetes conditions within the community, an essential part of the situational awareness framework is to identify, understand and assess the community and its residents level of awareness of being diabetic, the gravity of the disease on their health, and what can be done to mitigate such problems.

Once this is completed, we would have a panoramic assessment of the diabetic problems at hand as well as the current community awareness of the prevalence of diabetes within their community.
