CMS Updates from HCBS Conference

- Statewide Transition Plan:
 - Key elements for Final Approval*:
 - > Summary of completed and validated site-specific assessments, including aggregated outcomes
 - Draft remediation strategies with timelines for resolution by the end of the transition period
 - Detailed plan for identifying and evaluating those settings presumed to have institutional characteristics
 - Process for communicating with beneficiaries who are currently in settings that cannot or will not come into compliance
 - Description of ongoing monitoring and quality assurance to ensure all settings remain in full compliance with the setting criteria
 - Updated version of the STP is posted for minimum 30 day public comment period and widely distributed



CMS Updates from HCBS Conference

• Statewide Transition Plan, continued:

"States should continue progress in assessing existing operations and identifying milestones for compliance that result in Final STP approval by March 17, 2019"*

 CMS staff indicated they want heightened scrutiny submissions by 2020 to allow time for review

CMS Updates from HCBS Conference

• Conflict of Interest requirement:

"When states are out of compliance with the regulation, CMS may require a detailed corrective action plan (CAP) individualized and tailored to the state's particular situation."*

- SCDHHS submitted with ID/RD waiver renewal
- Session provided some resources to help us with mapping the system and making required changes

Statewide Transition Plan & Milestones

- Milestone document:
 - Based on information provided in STP
 - Requires specific dates on when actions have been or will be completed
 - Goal is to submit this document to CMS by end of September/early October with dates in place to address:
 - > Setting remediation
 - Heightened scrutiny
 - > Beneficiary communication and relocation
 - > STP public notice and submission for Final Approval



Statewide Transition Plan & Milestones

- Statewide Transition Plan:
 - Revisions to align with Milestone document will begin
 - Include content as required by CMS (Key Elements)
 - Contributions from DHHS Staff and DDSN staff will be needed
 - Goal is to do a 45 day public notice and comment period
 - > Plan to include some type of public meetings, webinars
 - Goal is submission to CMS for Final Approval review in early spring 2019



ADHC CAP Review Process

- Status Update:
 - 81 site visits completed
 - 71 CAPs approved
 - 7 currently under review
 - 1 non-responsive provider
 - 2 settings closed
- One setting state level HCB Setting Quality Review Process
 - Notification sent to provider, participants
 - Site visit to occur next week
 - Review by External Stakeholder Committee later this fall



DDSN CAP Review Process

• Status:

- Draft procedure in place
- Plan to include technical assistance for providers who need to revise CAPs prior to approval
- Still developing state level HCB Setting Quality Review Process
 - > CMS provided technical assistance: research on other states' process to aid in development of ours



Person-centered Planning Workgroup

Updates:

- Personal Planning Toolkit available
 - Optional tool designed for waiver participants and families
 - Assist with preparation for meeting with their case managers
- Person-centered planning educational presentation
 - > Target audience: waiver participants and families
 - ➤ Goal is to help people understand the personcentered planning process and how they can create a plan to make choices for their future
 - > Will be ready soon!
