DD Council believes that the system in SC will be enhanced with some of the continuation and new grants and they look forward to working with some great organizations.
- Division of Behavioral Health at DHHS is working on a carve-in of RBHS (Rehabilitative Behavioral Health Services) associated outpatient mental health services to Managed Care effective July 1, 2016. Four statewide trainings were held at the end of March and beginning of April. The carve in is for all providers of RBHS and associated outpatient MH (mental health) services (public and private).
